



Maternity base is a high risk mixed antenatal and postnatal ward. The ward also has a transitional care facility for mothers with babies who require additional care needs. Women and their babies receive care from the multidisciplinary team. There is an escalation policy within the Trust that suppports rotation of staff through the service. Staff are deployed from other areas when additional staffing is required.

Although actual staffing levels have been below agreed targets on 15 occassions throught the month, the actual bed occupancy has been reduced which has meant **Staffing Concerns** that escalation to the matron has not been necessary Number of shifts where staffing levels are not compliant with planned levels 15 Number of staffing related concerns escalated to Matron or higher

Ward Manager's Statement

Maintaining safe staffing levels on maternity base is complex due to the unpredictable nature of labour and admission to the unit. A senior midwife reviews staffing levels every 4 hours across the unit to ensure safety is maintained at all times. Midwives are redeployed to areas with greatest need when necessary. The ward manager has worked clinically to support the area when staffing levels have been reduced and bed occupancy is high. There have been no complaints or safety incidents related to staffing levels in this month.
