

## **Narrative**

There were no red flag incidents in May. The nurse to patient ratio did not exceed 1:9. there was on staffing concern escalated to the Matron when we had to employ an agency staff nurse to ensure safe staffing levels. The shift leader throughout the month has not been supernumery as they have had to take a team of patients, when this has occurred the ward manager has stepped in to coordinate patient flow. The ward team is supported by HDU staff in their role as outreach. Any further deficits in staffing is covered by bank

## **Matron Assurance Statement**

Staffing concerns raised on one occasion in May due to unforeseen sickness with staff phoning in at very late notice and the shift lead being unable to ensure further staff being accessed as Bank or Agency or being able to access staff from GED due to the staffing requirements of their areas. Prior to this the staffing for the ward and the numbers were safe and Patient Safety was not compromised. As a result of this and my escalation as Matron to the Gynaecology Management Team there is a current review of permissions of being able to access Agency Staff in order to prevent low staffing numbers which can potentially impact on Patient Safety. On two occasions were the Ward Manager has identified unsafe staffing levels for patient to nurse rations, agency staff have been approved and this has provided safe patient care.
