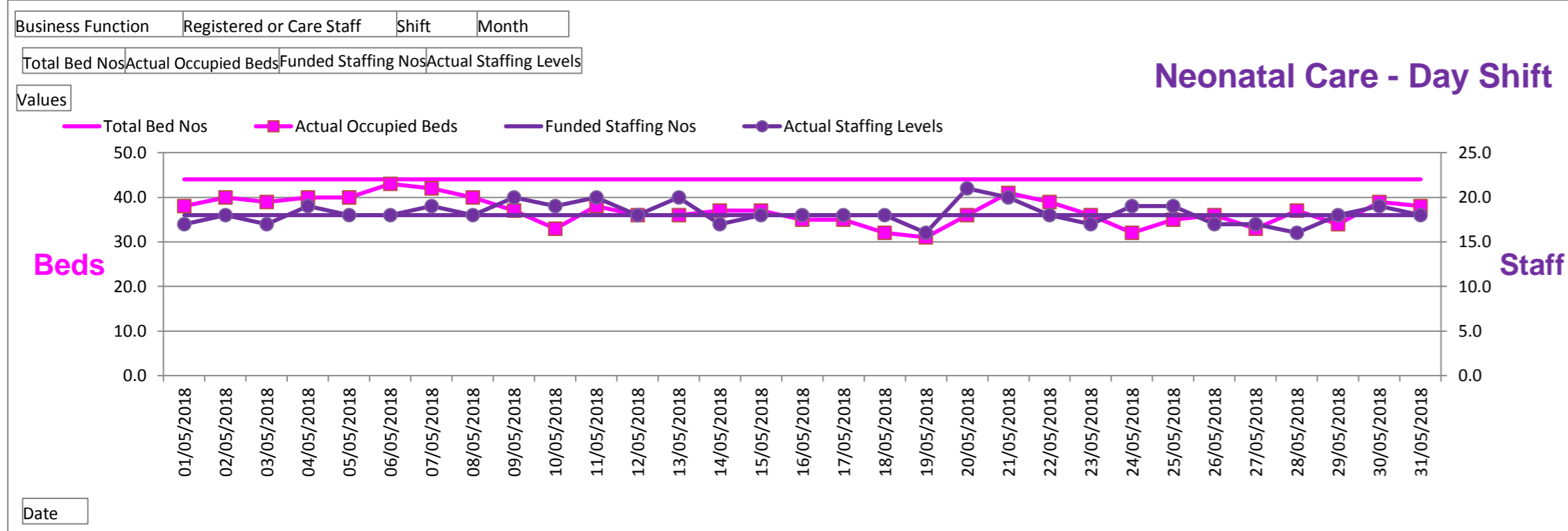

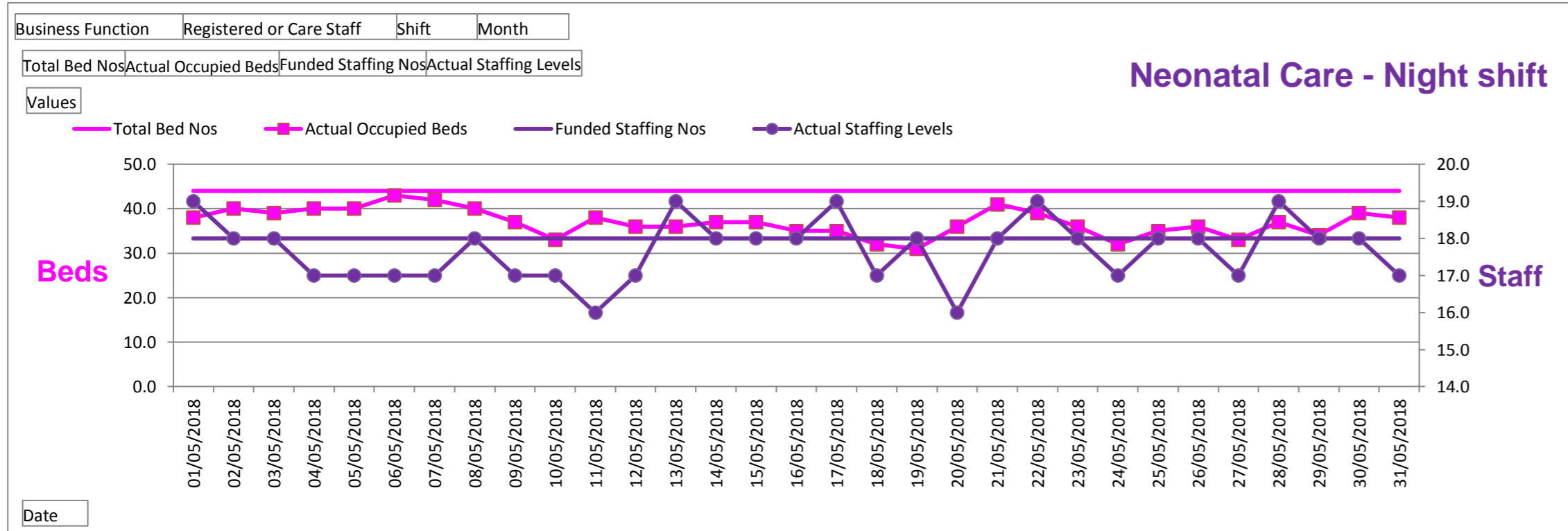
Day Shift
