


Staffing Report - Neonatal Care July 2018 Last updated: 09/08/2018





## The overall occupancy for the month of July was 73.1%, with Intensive Care at 84.9%, High Dependency at 65.3% and Low Dependency at 86.1%. There were no staffing breaches for the 15th month in a row, as staff continue to work flexibly to meet the needs of the service. Band 5 recruitment is in progress with 7 WTE successful at interview and a further recruitment commenced to fill remaining posts. 3 WTE Band 6 staff have been successful at interview to commence their ANNP training in September 18 and these posts are also out to advert. There is also a recruitment process in place for Band 3 unregistered but clinical staff who will be


