

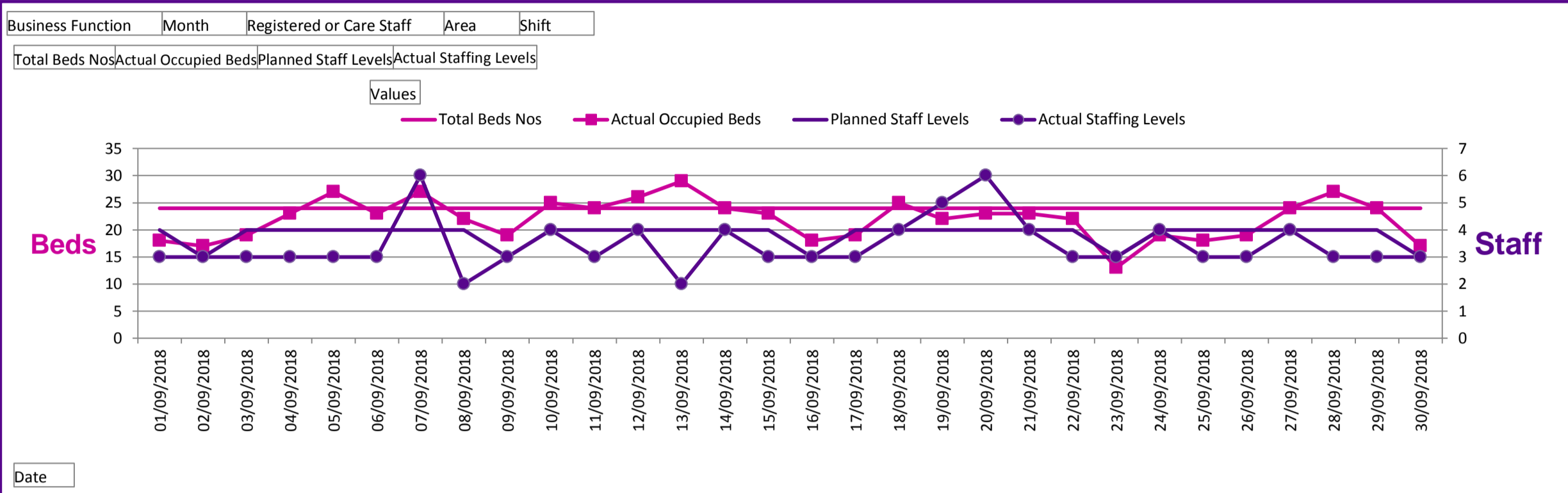

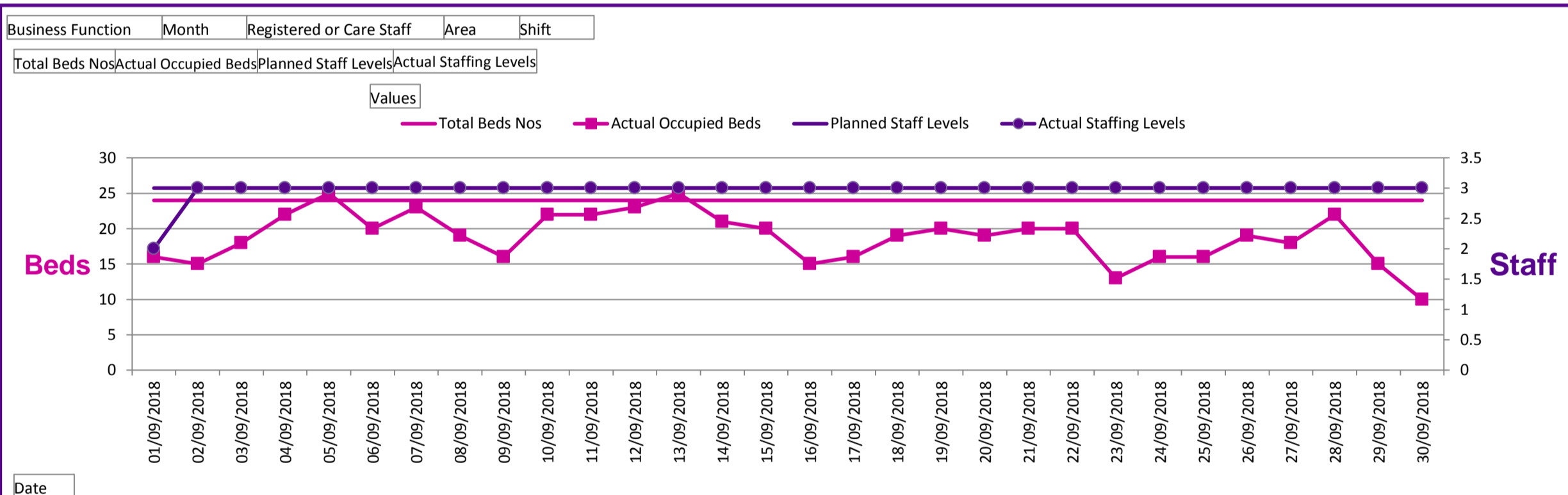
Day Shift
