


Number of shifts lost to Sickness Absence






Narrative

In conjunction with the two Gynaecology Matrons a weekly cross-check of staffing was reviewed in advance as a proactive measure to ensure at all times safer staffing was compliant on the Gynaecology Ward. This provided a through analysis of staffing with measure put in place to ensure safer staffing was maintained at all times. In advance planning this allowed the booking of Bank Shifts and where required the booking of Agency Staff. On two occasions due to unforeseen sickness staffing levels were affected which were then escalated to the Gynaecology Matron on one occasion and the Duty manager on a second. Immediate actions were put in place to deploy staff from other areas.



All night shifts throughout the month of March remained within Safe and effective staffing limits. Through proactive planning the use of Bank Staff and Agency Staff where required was utilised in order to accommodate all night shifts throughout the month. On nights were acuity was higher there were also options to deploy staff from other Gynaecology areas to provide patient delivery of care.
