

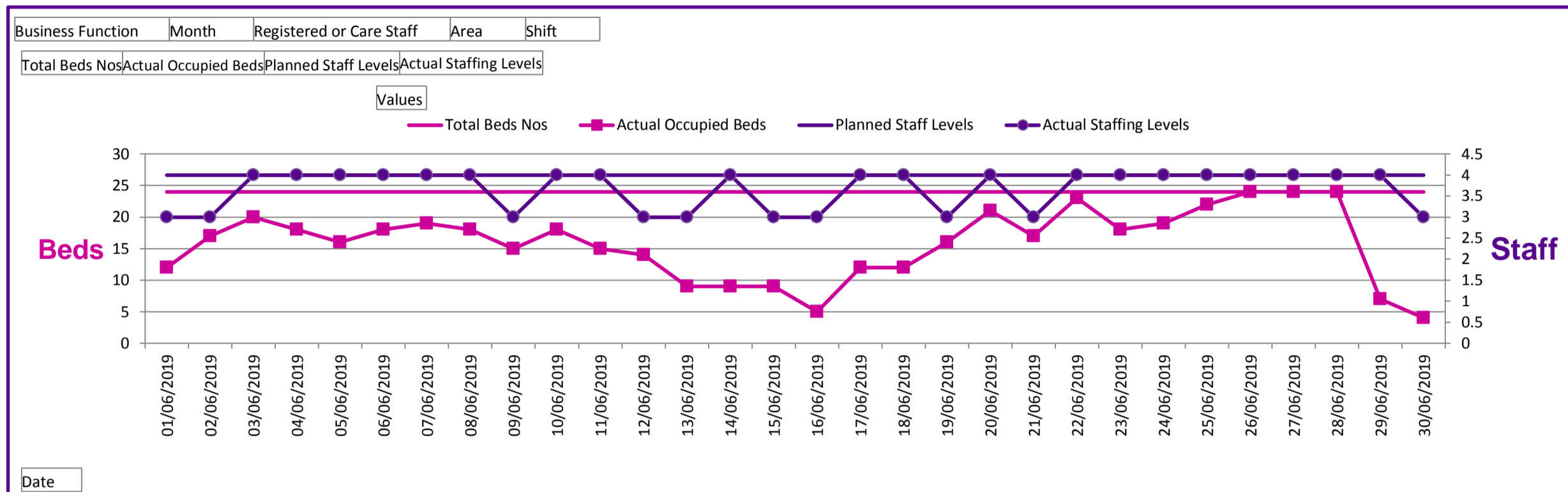

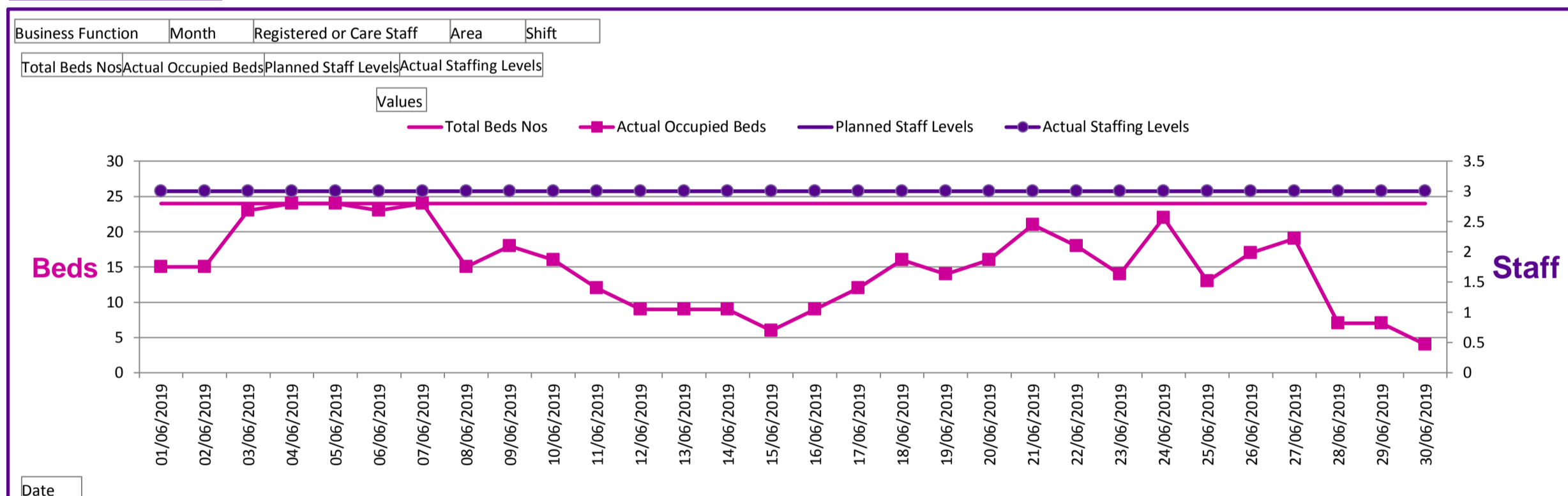
Day Shift
