

From the graphs, there appears to be 4 day shifts and 6 night shifts where staffing does not appear to meet the agreed staffing levels, however this is due to a robust system where staff are flexed across maternity services to support areas of high acuity. A reduction in staff on the MLU therefore reflects lower occupancy on the MLU and staff moving to other areas to provide a safe maternity service. Likewise the graph also demonstrates that in times of high acuity within the MLU, staff has been redeployed to MLU to assist, and staffing levels were higher than agreed levels at that time. Staff maintain one to one care in established labour and escalate any issues to the maternity bleep holder.
