

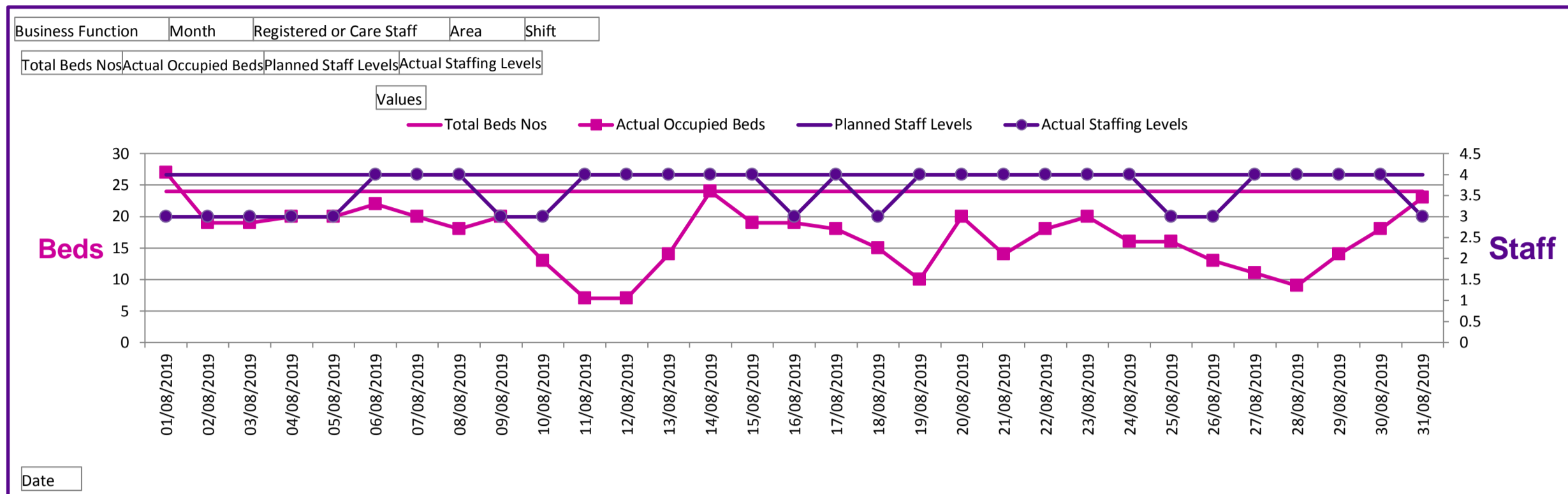

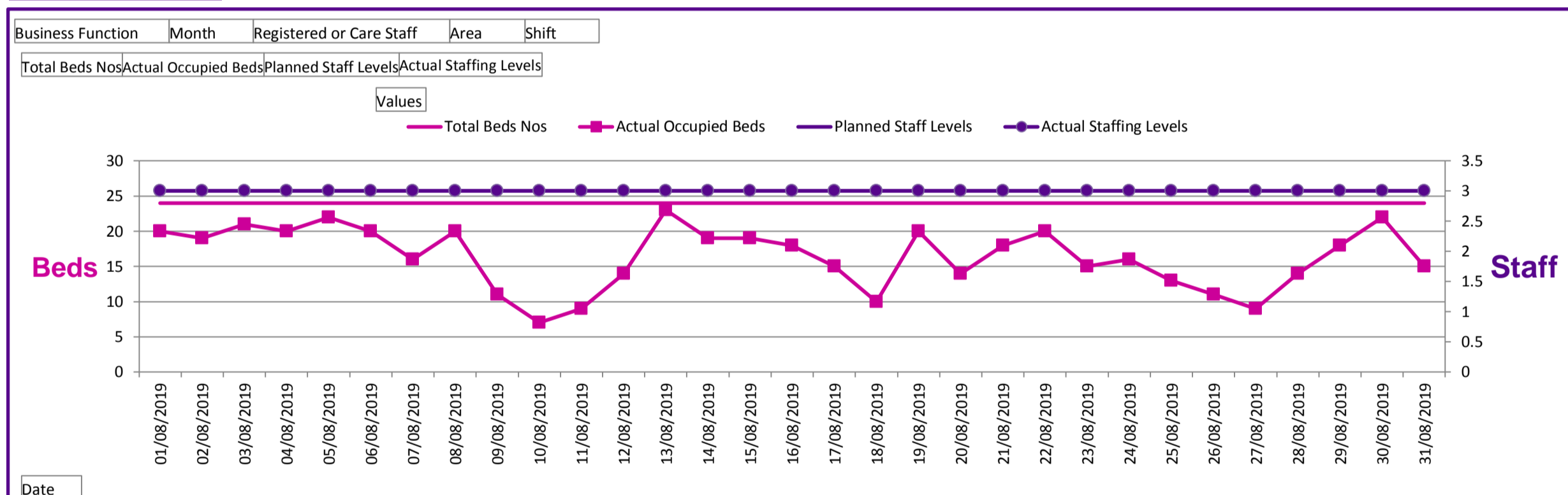
Day Shift
