



Staffing levels throughout the month of November have been stable however short term sickness has seen a reduction in one registered nurse on 5 shifts throughout the month. Fortunately the ward bed occupancy on these occasions the bed occupancy has not exceeded 24 inpatients and a maximun ratio of 1:8 occured on shifts were ther was a reduction in planned staff. On 4 occasions inpatient level were above 24 meaning HCA support was working at a 1:15 ratio.



Night staffing of the ward has been stable throughout November, sickness and vacancies have been covered through the use of Bank and Agency Nurses. The bed occupancy again was above 24 inpatients on 28/11/19 which therfore has affected the nurse to patient ratio
