
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Narrative

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Staffing Concerns

Although there were 58 shifts not covered during this month due to sickness, this has an impact on the staffing levels, these incidents were escalated to the 104 bleep holder and staff redeployed to ensure patient safety manager worked clinically to support staffing. On numerous occasions the acuity did not require any staff to be redeployed.

Ward Manager's Assurance Statement

Staffing is monitored on a 4 hourly basis by the 104 bleep holder who has an overall view of the whole of the maternity service. Staff are moved between areas depending on activity, in order to provide a safe maternity service. There is an escalation policy in place when there are concerns around staffing and activity.

Beds Occupied	Of the total beds, the number that have a patient in the bed
WTE Funded	WTE stands for Whole Time Equivalent. Funded WTE is the number of staff that is planned to be on a shift at any one time.
WTE Actual	Of the Funded WTE, the actual staffing level for the shift.
Registered	A Registered Nurse is one whom has qualified to practice as a nurse and is registered as such with the Royal college of Nursing or Royal College of Midwives
Unregistered	Unregistered staff are care staff that assist nurses with the day to day care of patients
