# Welcome to MIDWIFE AT HOME TEAM

If you are choosing to have your baby at Home you will be under the care of the Midwife at Home Team for every step of your pregnancy.

#### **Antenatal Care**

The Midwife at Home Team provide a 24-hour service, seven days a week. Giving you access to a known midwife throughout your pregnancy, birth and after your baby is born.

The continuity of care that the team provide makes it easy to develop relationships with the team of midwives over the course of your pregnancy, achieving more continuity and one to one care determined by your individual needs and circumstances.

If you are cared for by the Midwife at Home Team, you will be able to choose from a range of suitable locations for the majority of your antenatal appointments, whether that be at a local clinic or at home.

## Where will I have my appointments?

The majority of your antenatal appointments will be carried out by your named midwife and your appointments can take place at your home, Children's Centre or the hospital. We aim to provide appointments at a time and place that suits you.

You will also be given an opportunity to meet the other midwives in the team at some time during your pregnancy.

If you develop any complex care needs during your pregnancy you will be referred to an appropriate obstetrician but we will share care with the consultants where this is appropriate. We will discuss this with you should this need arise.

# **Care during birth**

As part of the continuity pathway our aim is that a midwife you have met or know from the team will care for you either during your labour or caesarean section.

### **Postnatal care**

Following the birth of your baby most of your postnatal care will be provided by your named midwife and her partner midwife who will visit you at home.
