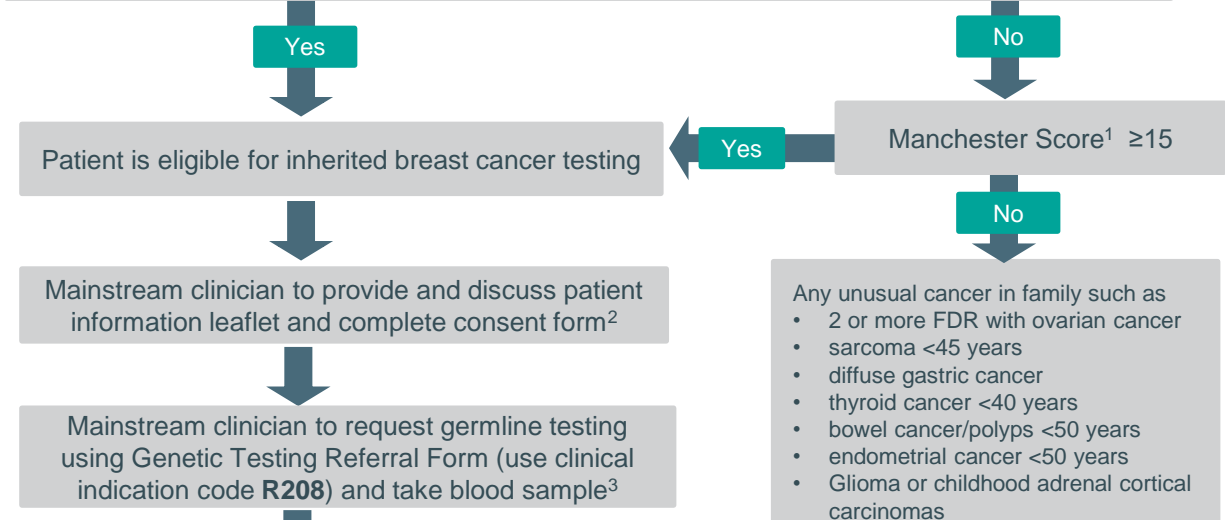

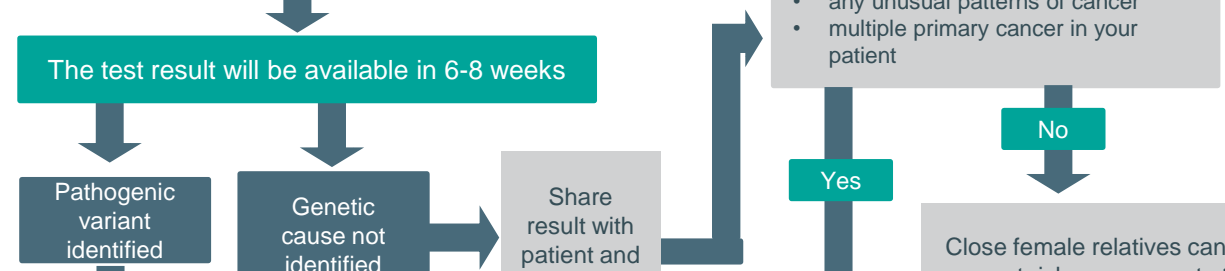
Does the individual with breast cancer meet latest Genomic Test Directory Criteria? V5.1 (May 2023) criteria summarised below. Breast cancer definition now INCLUDES high grade DCIS and grade 1 breast cancers:

- Breast cancer under 40 years OR
- Bilateral breast cancer, both < 50 years, OR
- Triple negative breast cancer < 60 years, OR
- Male breast cancer at any age, OR
- Breast cancer <45 years and a first degree relative (FDR) with breast cancer < 45 years, OR
- Ashkenazi Jewish ancestry and breast cancer at any age

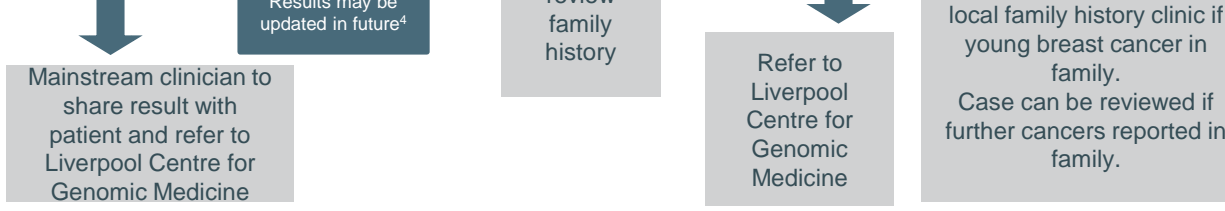
